

## PHASES OF DOCUMENT DEVELOPMENT LIFE CYCLE

### 04 Editing


Review and revise the document to enhance readability, fix errors, and ensure consistency.

### 03 Development

Write the content, ensuring accuracy, clarity, and completeness.

### 05 Maintenance

Continuously update and refine the document to reflect new information or changes.



### 02 Design

Create a layout and style guide that aligns with the document's purpose and audience needs.

### 01 Planning

Define the document's purpose, audience, and structure to set clear objectives.
